2015-2016 Advanced High School Programs of Study Application- IB/AICE

Applications must be received at the appropriate Cambridge (AICE) or International Baccalaureate (IB) school in your zone between January 20, 2015 and February 13, 2015. Applications may be submitted in person or by mail. Any application received for a program out of zone will be routed to the appropriate zone school. Parents will be notified via letters of acceptance or denial into the AICE or IB program starting March 6, 2015. Parents must submit the letter of intent back to the appropriate school postmarked by March 17, 2015. Parents may accept enrollment in only one advanced program of study.

Please note: Parents must complete a student assignment application with the Lee County Student Assignment Office either in person or at studentassignment.leeschools.net and attach the receipt to this application. Any student accepted into an AICE or IB program will not be officially assigned to the corresponding school in his/her zone until an intent form is signed by the incoming student **and** his/her parent or guardian.
